- Increase the engagement of all students through the implementation of a broad range of relevant pedagogical approaches.
- Improve teacher and other staff capability through coaching, mentoring and professional development in order to improve each student's performance.

Our initiatives include

- The development of a school data plan that clearly articulates processes around the collation and analysis of student data and identifies how this data is considered in curriculum planning processes.
- The implementation of evidence-based pedagogies (including zones for learning, balanced literacy, process-based learning and walker learning) in order to better meet the individual needs of students.
- Utilising targeted additional teacher aide support to enable further opportunities for explicit teaching and to provide capacity building opportunities for staff.
